

Pediatric Development Center's Berkshire Early Autism Resources



Our Berkshire Early Autism Resources (BEAR) provides intensive therapies to eligible children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) up to three years of age, who are receiving services from an Early Intervention Program, and reside in Berkshire County.

Our program is a Massachusetts Department of Public Health certified specialty service provider. This enables us to offer intensive programming for eligible children.

In collaboration with your family and your child's primary Early Intervention Program (EIP), the BEAR Program will continue to provide family-focused services.

Our goal is to provide a uniquely individualized program created for your child.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible for this Massachusetts Department of Public Health SSP, your child must have received one of the following confirmed diagnoses:

- Autism
- Pervasive Developmental Disorder – Not otherwise specified (PDD-NOS)
- Rett's Disorder
- Autism Spectrum Disorder



NEXT STEPS:

- In conjunction with your EIP, you will complete the BEAR/SSP Referral form and your Service Coordinator will forward it to the BEAR Program Manager
- A joint visit with your family, your service coordinator, and the BEAR Program Manager will then be scheduled.
- Resources available to help the family obtain a diagnosis will be discussed.
- Necessary information will be gathered to determine appropriate programming for your child.
- BEAR services begin!

- Floor Time
- Applied Behavioral Analysis

- Communication Systems
- Sensory Integration
- Activity Schedules
- Treatment Notebooks



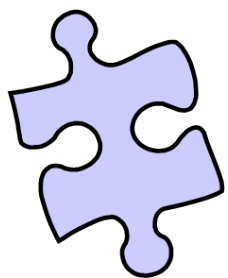
FUNCTIONAL OUTCOMES
